PASTORS CORNER

Are you Being Fed?

Is your faith growing? Is your sense of connection with God, your family, or your friends growing? Or when do you feel like you are growing does it seem like it's happening in fits and starts? If any of this sounds familiar, perhaps you're not being fed. St. Paul wrote about this. He wrote that in the beginning of our faith, we were given milk, but as grow we need more substantial food for faith. For most of us our lessons in faith ended when we received Confirmation. How old were you when you were confirmed? Has it been a while?

Are you more mature now than you were then? Maybe it's time for more substantial food for faith.

I know that for a lot of us when we realize we want more we don't know how to start. We pick up the bible with a determination to finally read it from cover to cover. We dutifully begin with Genesis 1:1. As we move forward we become frustrated and confused, especially if we get all the way to Leviticus. Maybe we think that if we start with the New Testament it will make more sense. So when we open Mathew Chapter 1 and were greeted with genealogy! We realize we need some guidance and go to the Bible book store. Here we see shelves and shelves of books and it seems even more overwhelming. Our enthusiasm for this drop off as fast as the enthusiasm we had for the treadmill in the corner.

There is a solution. Thanks to one parishioner. She asked if she could bring a bible study course that she'd heard about to the parish. We started with one session of the Great Adventure Bible series. Soon they grew so fast that we had to increase the session to 4 groups meeting throughout the week to accommodate the size and the schedules of everyone.

¿Está siendo alimentado?

¿Está creciendo en su fe? Tiene una sensación de conexión con Dios, su familia o sus amigos cercanos? O cuando siente que está creciendo parece como si estuviera sucediendo a trompicones? Si algo de esto le suena familiar, tal vez usted no está siendo alimentado. St. Paul escribió esto. Él escribió que en el principio de nuestra fe, nos dieron leche, pero ya con crecimiento necesitamos comida más sustancial para la fe. Para la mayoría de nosotros nuestras lecciones de fe terminaron cuando recibimos la confirmación. ¿Cuántos años tenias cuando fueron confirmados? ¿Ha sido un rato? ¿Está más maduro de lo que era entonces? Quizás es el momento para más comida sustancial en la fe.

Sé que para muchos de nosotros, cuando nos damos cuenta de que queremos más que no sabemos cómo empezar. Recogemos la biblia con la determinación de finalmente leerlo de principio a fin. Obedientemente comenzamos con Génesis 1:01. A medida que avanzamos nos frustramos y confundimos, sobre todo si seguimos todo el camino hasta el Levítico. Tal vez si empezamos con el Nuevo Testamento habrá más sentido. Así que cuando abrimos Mathew Capítulo empezamos a leer sobre la genealogía. Nos damos cuenta de que necesitamos una cierta dirección y vamos a la tienda de libros a buscar orientación. Aquí vemos muchos y muchos de libros y parece aún más abrumadora. Nuestro entusiasmo por este cae tan rápido como el entusiasmo que teníamos para la cinta en la esquina.

Hay una solución. Gracias a una parroquiana. Ella preguntó si podía traer un curso de estudio bíblico de cual había oído a la parroquia. Comenzamos con una sesión de la serie Gran Aventura de la Biblia. Pronto crecieron tan rápidamente que tuvimos que aumentar las sesiones a 4 grupos que se reúnen a lo largo de la semana para acomodar los horarios de todos.
