Our Gifts for Others

It's Tuesday evening and you finally have a chance to watch that nature documentary on PBS that you've been looking forward to. As you watch it you're more engrossed than you expected. You've been drawn into the episode when suddenly...there's a break for "Pledge Week." You know that it's important for people to support the programming, but you wanted to watch the program. Do you check-out for a while? Maybe get something to snack on or, channel surf for a while? So why would I bring this up when we're supposed to be going through the Mass? I'll be some of you realize where we are in the Mass. We've just finished the Prayers of the Faithful, so now we're dealing with the Preparation of the Gifts. The main point that I want to make is that this is **not** pledge week.

The preparation is not simply "taking the collection." Instead this is a continuation of our relationship with God and our neighbors. It's a relationship that's been formed for thousands of years. Remember that the first Church wasn't able to meet in a building, we met in homes. When we gathered on Sundays, we brought the bread and the wine for consecration. And we brought our extra food, clothes, or money to build up the Kingdom and to proclaim "Good News to the Poor." This is why that the gifts are presented by members of the congregation. We're recalling our roots and the importance of the moment. More importantly, we're recognizing God's love and mercy that He's given to us through our gifts. Then we bring those gifts that we've received back to God to be sanctified and used by God to be given to others.

Our Father In Faith

The Letter to the Hebrews today sings a hymn of praise to Abraham and to his faith, upon which are founded the religions of Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. Abraham is called "father" in faith by more people on earth than anybody else, numerous as the sands of the seashore or the stars of the heavens. Hebrews tells us it was this foundational faith that led Abraham to obey God's call when he heard it, though he was called to journey to a land he did not know and told he would father a mighty race through a marriage he thought was barren. But Abraham's faith, the author of Hebrews tells us, was his realization of what he hoped for, and the evidence of what he could not see. How often are we, in simple daily events of our own Christian vocation, called to an unfamiliar place or told we are to do something we do not believe we can? How fortunate we are to have Father Abraham as our guide and example!
